Tomatoes

Angelo Petitti's favorite tomato plants are hand-selected and grown for their delicious flavor, productivity, ease of care, and success in the home garden or containers. Begin with a full sun site (6+ hours of direct sunlight), 6-12" of well-drained, workable, nutrient rich soil containing 50% **Petitti Planting Mix** and 50% pre-existing soil. For container gardens, begin with at least a 12" wide by 10-12" deep pot and fresh **Petitti Potting Mix** or **Petitti Planting Mix** each year to avoid any reoccurring diseases or insect problems. During planting, apply **Espoma® Tomato-tone®** and **Garden Lime**. Repeat Tomato-tone® applications, according to package directions. Liquid Miracle-Gro® and Osmocote® work nicely, too. Keep tomatoes evenly watered, especially during fruit development. Spray **Bonide® Rot-Stop®** with easily absorbed calcium to help prevent blossom end rot, along with **Bonide® Tomato & Blossom Set Spray**, a natural plant hormone, to promote heavier blooming and fruit development. **Stakes or cages** are essential for large producers and tall, vining varieties. Add companion plants such as marigolds, basil, parsley, chives, and onions to help boost overall tomato growth and yields.

'Big Beef'	Amazing vigor, DR & early, XL, 8-12 oz. extra meaty, tasty fruit. AAS, I, G	73
'Big Boy'	Long-time fav, large yields, XL, 10-16 oz., smooth, red, meaty, eat fresh, cook or can. I	78
'Big Zac'	Bred from 2 amazing heirlooms, enormous 4-6 lbs. fruit, red, ribbed, meaty & delicious. I, G	80
'Bush Champion'	Compact, 24" tall, early yields, big, smooth, 8-12 oz. fruits, excellent flavor, good DR. C, D	65
'BushSteak'	Small space hybrid, 20-24" tall, big, globe, 8-12 oz. fruits, meaty, tasty & early. C, D	65
'Celebrity'	Classic, all-purpose, great DR, big yield, 8 oz., crack resist., strong. AAS, C, D, G	70
'Early Girl' I 'Early Girl Bush' D	Outstanding, extra early, heavy crops of uniform, slightly flattened, blemish resistant, 4-6 oz., full, firm & meaty scarlet fruits, reliable. C, D, I & G	52 54
'Fourth of July'	"Greatest Early Tomato" , plentiful, flavorful, 4 oz., red, ready by the 4 th ! I	49
'Husky Red'	A favorite patio tomato, full size, 5-7 oz., tasty red globes, sturdy stemmed, dwarf variety. C, I	68
'Jet Star'	Popular hybrid, all-purpose, good DR, lower acidity, 8-12 oz. red globes, sweet & mild. I	72
'Lemon Boy'	Large harvests, lemony-yellow, 8 oz., flavorful, mild, sweet, low acid. I	72
'Park's Whopper'	Productive, big, juicy, crack-resistant, 4" wide, ripen uniformly, excellent DR. I	65
'Patio'	Large yields, 2" wide, round, red, dwarf, perfect for small gardens & containers. C, D	70
'Pink Girl'	Smooth, glossy, deep pink to red, heavy yield, 6-8 oz., juicy, rich but low acid flavor. D	76
'Primo Red'	Compact, early yield, smooth red globes, 8 oz., firm & tasty with excellent DR. C, D	68
'Supersteak'	Super-size, 2 lbs., beefsteak flavor, meaty texture, Burpee favorite. I	80
Cherry Tomatoes:		
'Cherry Punch'	Tasty, 1 oz. red beauties 30% more vitamin C, 40% more lycopene than average. I	48
'Husky Red Cherry'	Large yields, tasty, 1", round, red, perfect for small gardens, sturdy, dwarf variety. C, I	65
'Large Red Cherry'	Vigorous vine, high yield, top quality, 1-1.25" red, round, tasty all season long. I	70
'Sparky'	Early, prolific & flavorful red & gold striped, 1 oz., 1.25" fruit, very sweet, high yield. AAS, I	60-70
'Sungold'	Abundant, bite-sized, gold to orange, juicy, sugary-sweet, vigorous, long harvest. I	57
'Sunsugar'	Golden-yellow, .5 oz., crack resistant, tangy, sugary & smooth developing early, vigorous. I	62
'Super Sweet 100'	Sweet, tangy, bite-sized, 1" round, red, grape-like clusters, long harvest. I	65
'Sweet Million'	Slightly smaller, more vigorous, better crack/disease resistance than 'Sweet 100'. I, G	65
'Tumbler'	Bred for containers & hanging baskets, cascading habit is early & productive, up to 6 lbs. of 1.25" sweet & tasty red fruit, will continue to flower & fruit throughout the season. C, D	49

Grape Tomatoes:		
'Cupid'	Large clusters, high yields, 1" long fruit, extra-sweet, disease & crack resistant. I	66
'Napa Grape'	Elongated, shiny red 1" globes, high sugar content & sweetness all summer. I	65
'Red Grape'	Hybrid produces abundant sugary sweet, firm, bright red, oval, 1 oz. fruits, 12-16 per cluster. I	70
Heirloom Tomatoes:		
'Amish Paste'	Old-fashioned, large, 8-12 oz. oxheart crossed with a plum, delicious, juicy, meaty, few seeds. I	85
'Brandywine'	Popular, 1 lb. beefsteak, rosy-pink, succulent, rich, best flavor of all time. I, G	80
'Cherokee Purple'	Reliable, 8-12 oz., purple-pink-brown skin, deep red flesh, sultry, smoky-sweet taste. I, G	85
H. M. 'Genuwine'	Hybrid fusion of rich, Italian 'Costoluto Genovese' & all-time fav 'Brandywine', 11 oz. delicious I	70-75
H. M. 'Jersey Boy'	Heirloom marriage of reliable 'Rutgers' & all-time fav 'Brandywine', 10-15 oz. sweet yet acidic. I	70
'Hillbilly'	Large beefsteak, 2 lbs., orange-yellow streaked skin, red-pink inside, low acid, fruity taste. I	85
'Marglobe'	Dependable, multipurpose, round, red, crack-resistant, medium size, vigorous producer. D	70
'Mortgage Lifter'	Enormous, meaty, sweet, 2- 2.5 lbs., smooth, round, pink-red flesh, very few seeds. I	80
'Mr. Stripey'	Huge, 9oz.-2lbs., ridged, yellow w/pink to red stripes, sweet, mild, low-acid, few seeds. I	80
'Rutgers'	Medium sized, reliable, 7 oz. round, red fruit, good flavor, great all-purpose, good DR. I	78
'Yellow Pear'	Tall plants, large harvests of clear yellow, 2" long pear-shaped, sweet, zesty cherry-like fruits. I	71
Plum Tomatoes:		
'La Roma'	Heavy yields, 5-8 oz. plum-shaped fruit, larger than original 'Roma', meaty, few seeds. D	62
'Little Napoli'	Bright red, meaty, full flavor, hybrid, pear-shaped fruits, 2-2.5 oz., excellent for sauces & salsa. D	60-65
'San Marzano'	"Classic Italian Plum Fewest Seeds" , heavy yields, 3.5" long, tapered fruit, classic taste. I	70
'SuperSauce'	XXL Roma, 2lbs. each, 5" tall & wide, tasty & multipurpose for canning, slicing & salads. I	70

Key:
AAS = All-America Selections Winner, varieties trialed & tested by expert judges, awarded for superior, reliable garden performance
C = Compact variety, excellent plant for containers & small space gardens
D = Determinate or bush variety producing several fruits to harvest at one time
DR = Disease resistance
G = Grafted variety, extraordinary yields & disease resistance from strong rootstock & desirable variety (scion) splice grafted
I = Indeterminate or vining variety that produces fruit throughout the growing season
